General Instructions

1. Bring holiday homework in a beautifully decorated folder.
2. Parents are requested to guide their children, while doing their homework, assignments and let the child only do the work independently.
3. Originality of the work will be appreciated.
4. Project / Homework will be assessed on the basis of neatness, creativity and originality of ideas. Kindly do the homework on A4 size coloured sheets/scrap file.
5. Great emphasis should be laid on newspaper reading daily. Pick 5 new words from the newspaper every day, find their meanings and frame sentences for each word listed.
6. As good handwriting and presentation plays a vital role in an individual's personality so children should practice Cursive Writing and सुलेख with proper strokes.
7. Revise tables from 2 to 15.
8. Try and converse in English at home.
9. Limit screen time to 30 minutes a day and monitor regularly. To make them physically fit, make sure that they are involved in atleast 30 minutes of physical exercise a day.
10. Encourage your children to use magic words like Thank you, Sorry, Please, etc.
11. By following the above-mentioned instructions, your child will develop good personality traits.

English
