





Book summary


A book summary gives the main idea and necessary proof without going into as much detail. Summaries will win out over full books. You can quickly memorize and understand the main idea and key points of the book.



Write a book review of Tenali Raman. Also make a cover page and put the review inside the cover page.





Make different objects using various Mathematical shapes with the help of rubber bands. A sample video is given for you.


