


## BUNNY FACE MASK






## MONEY STORY


The kids of grade 1 played a role of a seller and learned addition and subtraction using money. The exchange of value took place between the child and his family member who acted as a customer.

## MEMORY GAME




## IF YOU THINK

"The man who wins, Is the man who thinks".


To enable the students to recognize how their thoughts shape their lives, the students of grade 4 were asked to think and make a G.O. and write the qualities that we need to succeed in life.

# हिन्दी सद्भाव




## खेल-खेल में सीखो

## मेरी कलम से






## CIRCUMFERENCE OF A CIRCLE

## LET'S MAKE A BROCHURE


To make students understand about evolution in means of communication, a brochure making activity was conducted in grade 4. They made two different brochures on personal and mass means of communication.



## OCCURENCE OF ECLIPSES


The solar eclipse is one of the most important natural phenomena. To make the children understand how does it occur they were asked to do the activity with a torch and globe/ball.
